#### REGISTRATION

The American Society for Engineering Education will be held in Vancouver, BC, Canada for the 118th Annual Conference & Exposition. Please visit <u>http://www.asee.org/conferences-and-events/conferences/annual-conference/2011/registration</u> for registration details. Please note that as of Thursday, May 26, 2011, the "On-site" registration rate applies. This will be the prevailing rate until the conclusion of the conference.

For On-site: We will accept the following methods of payment: Visa, MasterCard, and American Express, as well as U.S. Dollars (the preferred currency), we will also accept Canadian Dollars

#### **PASSPORT INFORMATION**

All non-Canadian visitors must present appropriate travel documents in order to enter the country. US citizens do not need a visa to enter Canada, but must display a valid US passport.
